**Ongoing**

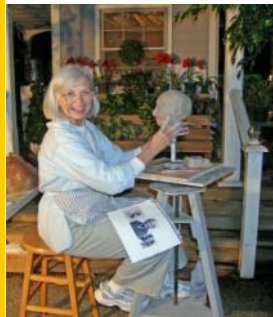
**Tuesday:** K-4th grade - 3:30 until 4:45pm
