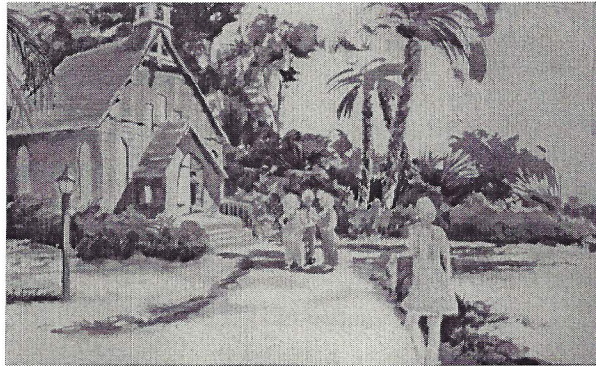


# Bob Fisher's Watercolors



Who is this guy?

Bob Fisher is a local artist who lives on St. Simons Island and has enjoyed painting in the Golden Isles for years. He is a member of both the Glynn Arts Association and the Coastal Center for the Arts, and he has taught watercolor classes at the Olde Town Arts Center in Brunswick, GA.

Bob is a professional Educator (MA Ed., G.W. University, Wash., DC) and an Engineer (M.S. Univ. of Tennessee, Knoxville, TN). Thus, Bob's knowledge of both art and science appear in his paintings and in the classes he teaches. His classes always follow a clear lesson plan that guarantees learning, and his engineering insights allow him to simplify difficult technical topics like perspective.

Bob's paintings are always fresh and bright because he starts with very wet paper and keeps it wet as long as possible—usually to the end. That is a skill he learned from Tony Couch, with whom Bob takes a class every spring. Couch's knowledge of symbolism and design principles is only exceeded by his ability to control paint on wet paper—his work is brilliant. Bob also takes at least one class each year with Tony VanHasselt, who Bob sees as the best outdoor watercolor painter alive today. Paper dries faster outdoors, so you've got to paint fast and loose. Both Tonys studied with Ed Whitney, and each in his own style continues that worthy tradition: start with a good plan and paint quickly.

Bob believes that one's "style" is whatever works at a particular time in one's life. Style evolves as each new experience brings insight and changes. But it never ends. Bob once framed this question for himself: "If it took me 4 years to become a physicist, 3 years to become an engineer, 2 years to become an educator, how long could it take to become an artist?" His answer: "There's no end to it, just the journey itself."
