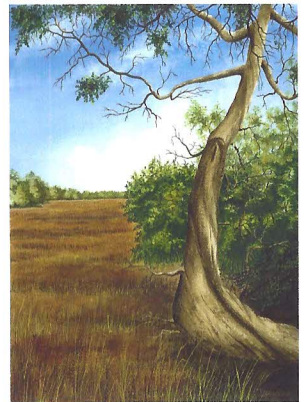

About the Artist

Bruce Shoemaker, a native Pennsylvanian, built a home and moved to the West Point area of Saint Simons Island in 1998 after living aboard his sailboat "Mariposa" in the Caribbean for five years. Bruce studied architecture and engineering at Penn State University and earned a BA degree in Physics from Bloomsburg University in 1966. He has been painting recreationally for over thirty-five years working primarily in oils and acrylics. Inspired by the work of David Armstrong, and somewhat limited by the practical aspects of living aboard, Bruce began working in watercolor in the mid 1990's. His love of boats and the water is reflected in many of his paintings. Painting professionally since 1999, Bruce has worked to go beyond the typical "watercolor look" developing a distinct style that explores enhanced dimensions of light, realism and vibrant color.

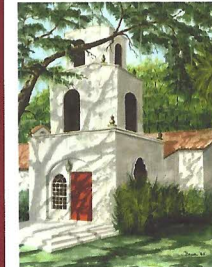

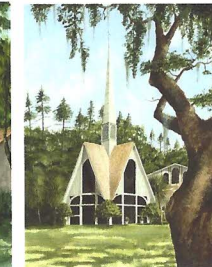

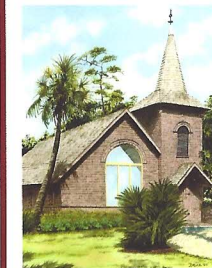
