Born in Bournemouth, England and now living on St. Simons Island, Bunty Stephens was influenced from an early age by her father, Harry Dawson, an artist who specialized in pen and ink, and charcoal drawings. With his encouragement she also studied for many years under the well known English watercolorist A.W. Leake.

World War II, marriage and children interrupted her career which was not resumed until 1965 when, then living in New York, she was invited by a friend to join a select group of artists studying under one of the foremost American portrait and landscape artists, Daniel Green. *N.A.*
